FAQ'S FOR INFIELD AND TRACK SIDE CAMPING FOR BEND CLASSIC 2025

BUMP IN –

You may arrive from Thursday 23rd of October from 10am – 6pm, **please note** if choosing to arrive on Friday the 24th of October, the time to enter your campsite will be between 9am and 12pm. Bump out on Sunday is 2 – 6pm.

ENTRY–

- To enter the campground area you will need to supply your camping and GA ticket at the gate upon arrival, ticket staff will point you in the direction of your camp spot (either trackside, or infield) and supply a wristband and car sticker, allocated to the specific area. The wristband must be worn all weekend for entry in and out of the precinct or camping area.

CONDITIONS –

- POWER - There is no provided power for your camp area, on either infield or trackside – you are welcome to use personal generators, but we ask that you limit noise from 10:30pm.
- FIRES –small enclosed fire pits are allowed – unless extreme heat occurs.
- BUSES – there are numerous buses internally taking people around the precinct, including to and from both camping areas, times and locations for the shuttle buses will be attached separately on the map and schedule.
- GAZEBOS – Gazebos may only be set up in the **TRACKSIDE** camping area on your allocated camp space.
- BBQS – Contained gas BBQ's are ok to use safely within the camp areas.

- AMENITIES – There are toilet and shower blocks located near each camping area – refer to map attached. Alternatively, there are multiple locations around the precinct, including the Main Welcome Centre, with toilet and shower facilities.
- GLASS – Absolutely NO glass is to be brought into the venue.
- ALCOHOL – We are a licensed venue so no alcohol is allowed to be brought in, Apex Bar x Dining will have the sale of alcohol throughout the venue over the weekend.
- FOOD AND DRINKS – You are allowed to bring in your own food and non-alcoholic drinks as you please, ensuring no glass.
- NOISE - Please respect the fact this is a Family Friendly event, and we expect noise to be minimised from 10:30pm nightly. Generators and noise to be reduced at this time please.

Security will be onsite all throughout the event at all areas, including camping.
